


















## SUNDAY

## OTHERSIDE

DURING THE CALIFORNICATION TOUR FLEA REACHED THE BREAKING POINT. WE HAD BEEN ON TOUR AND WERE IN AUSTRALIA, AND HE WAS PROBABLY FEELING HOW I FELT WITH THE BROKEN FEET, LIKE TOTALLY DONE. WE HAD A SIT-DOWN AND DECIDED TO REINVENT THE WAY WE TOURED -INSTEAD OF GOING FOR MONTHS AND MONTHS AND TAKING A FEW OFF, WE WERE GOING TO DO THREE WEEKS ON AND TEN DAYS OFF. AND OBVIOUSLY, YOU AREN'T MAKING THE KIND OF MONEY YOU WOULD MAKE, BECAUSE DURING THOSE TEN DAYS YOU HAVE TO PAY EVERY SINGLE SOUL WHO IS WORKING FOR YOU.
